Secondly, I desire and di-
rect that all my just debts
be paid, without delay, by
my executor hereinafter named
and appointed.

Thirdly, I give and be-
queath to my beloved wife,
for and during her natural life
or widowhood, all my estate,
both real and personal,
and on her death or marriage,
I desire all my estate, both
real and personal, to be
equally divided between my
heirs.

Fourthly, I hereby constitute
and appoint my beloved
wife, Margaret S. Dilley, exe-
cutor of this my last Will and
