Strickland, and my son Har-
roll W. Garrison, and I do give
and bequeath to each one of
my children whatever of my
property they now have in their

Fourth - I hereby constitute and
appoint Thomas B. Newton, Carroll
W. Garrison, and Isaac J. Strick-
land, executors of this my last
will and testament.
