I Robert Martin of said County being
of advanced age, and in feeble health, but of
sound mind, and disposing memory do make
ordain, and declare this my last and testament
hereby expressly revoking all former wills and
Codicils by me heretofore made.

Item 1st I desire any and all just debts I may
owe (if any) at the time of my death to be paid by
my Executors as soon as practicable without any
unnecessary delay.

Item 2nd I do hereby bequeath all of my Estate
of every kind and nature whatsoever in three equal
Shares, to my faithful and beloved wife Nancy -
my son George Washington Martin (usually
called Washington Martin) now residing in Florida
and my son Harrison B. Martin residing in West
Point Georgia, each an equal part share and share
alike.

Item 3rd I nominate and appoint my son
Harrison B. Martin and my friend William
P. Brown of Milton County as the Executors of this
my last will and testament, and to the effect they
will accept, and execute the trust,

dred and sixty eight.
