a certain child, to wit, Mollie
Jane Heansard, aged six years
a minor child, of said County,
to the said Angelina being
incapable to support and educate
said child) bound to Jones Laine
of said County, until she ar-
ries at the age of 21 years,
she having no estate to support
and educate herself.

The said Jones Laine binds
himself to take charge of the
person of said minor, to protect
clothe and educate said mi-
nor, so far as learning to read
and write the English language
is concerned, and the said
Jones Laine further agrees on
his part to teach said child
habits of industry, and that
the said child shall not be
mistreated by himself or any
other person, if in his power to
prevent it.

And the said Jones Laine
further obligates himself that
at the expiration of the said
minor child's minority, that he
will give said reasonable

One hundred dollars, personal
minor shall do faithful service
and conduct herself as a faith-
ful apprentice should do.
And the said Mollie Jane obli-
gates herself that she will remain
with the said Jones Laines, obey
all reasonable orders given her by
him, and she will remain
with him until she arrives at
the age of Twenty one years, unless
sooner removed by legal process.
All persons are hereby forbidden
to entice, persuade, or receive said
minor from the control or possession
of the said Jones Laines, under
penalty of the law.
