Mitchell County Wills and Bonds 1870 to 1916

Know all men by these presents, That we Charles Palmar as principal & David Ayres & John G. Sapp securities, acknowledge ourselves jointly & severally bound unto James L. Stewart Ordinary of said County, & his successors and assigns, in the full sum of Three Thousand dollars to the true payment of which well and truly to be made we bind ourselves & the heirs & executors of us & each of us jointly and severally by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated this 12th day January 1874

The condition of the above bond or obligation is such that if the above bound Charles Palmar, who was this day appointed Guardian of the person & property of Mary McLeod Minor Orphan Child of Andrew McLeod deceased, he acknowledging of the same by the acceptance of said Appointment & of Letters of Guardianship, of this date, shall well & truly maintain, clothe & educate said Orphan according to her circumstances & shall take good & lawful care of her person & property, according to the laws of this state, & shall annually make a just & true return of all his doings & doing herein, unto the said Ordinary & pay over all assets that may remain in his hands when said Guardianship shall legally terminate, then this obligation to be void, else to remain of full force,
