Spence carefully collect and preserve from waste or loss all the goods and chattels and effects of the said Bertha Cochran and make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all the Estate of said deceased and return the same to the Court of Ordinary of said County when so required and do make up such Estate and effects unto the legal and proper Administrator whenever he shall thereunto be lawfully required so that and faithfully perform the trust reposed in him then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force in law
