Johns and my lawful personal property to wit land and household and thirty head of cattle and two head of horses and forming themselves as the household and kitchen furniture one the place in which I live and reside free from all charge and limitation from wherever to pay or own property used benefit and behoof for ever with full power to dispose of the same by will or otherwise as she deems proper
