

In the Mitchell County, I, Elias McElvin of the County and State aforesaid being
of sound and disposing Mind and Memory in view of the uncertainty
of life and being desirous of making a certain disposition of that property
with which he King provided has as follows do make this my last
Will and Testament

First

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my
Executor hereafter named, as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed
of their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

Second

I will bequeath and devise to my son Robert, P. McElvin the following
Negroes viz Ned my negro Man about 22, twenty two years of age Alice a
girl about sixteen years of age George a boy about two years of age
Clim a woman about twenty two years of age and her Children Rosetta
about six months and Alice a woman about forty eight years
of age.

Third

I will bequeath and devise to my son James S. the following
Negroes viz Nancy a Woman about forty two years of age Benjamin
a Man about forty five years of age Anna a Girl about eighteen years
of age Charles a boy about twelve years of age Henry a boy about
ten years of age.

Fourth

I will bequeath and devise to my daughter Margaret, S. Gee wife
of Robert S. Gee and her Children by his present or any future
husband from the disposition of her present or any future husband
the following named Negroes viz Ruth a boy about twenty years old
Sarah a woman about twenty four of age Ruby a girl about twenty
years of age Ellen a girl about fifteen years of age Lucy a boy
about eight years of age Eliza a woman about thirty years of age
I appoint my son James S. trustee for the property herein bequeathed
to my Daughter Margaret, S. Gee and her Children.

Fifth

I will bequeath and devise to the children of my son John S. Gee
Mirza J. William J. Susan E. Henry R. John S. and Clara the following
Negroes viz Hannah a woman about thirty years of age and her three
children Tom a boy about thirty years of age Comet a girl about twelve
years of age Anna a girl about two years old and Penny a
girl about twelve years of age.

Sixth

I will bequeath and devise to the children of my son William H. viz
Sarah & William H. and Susan J. the following Negroes viz Nancy
a Man about forty years of age Beth a woman about thirty years of
age and his four Children viz Mary Jane a Girl about seven years
of age Emily a girl about fifteen years of age Ned a boy about
three years of age and Peter a boy about one year of age I appoint

Sixth
My dear Robert & I Trustee for the Children of my Son William H.
Also my Son James & I Trustee for the Children of my Son John G.
I also will and desire that each of the above named lots of property
be valued by three disinterested persons and the payment to the
less will be made equal.

Eighth
I will bequeath and devise to my Son Robert H., James, &
and my daughter Margaret J. Gee the following named lots
of Land Robert Set (116) One hundred and sixteen Set (184)
One hundred and eighty four Set (185) One hundred and
eighty five Set (177) One hundred and forty seven Set (178)
One hundred and forty eight Set (143) One hundred and forty
three, all lying and being in the Eleventh District of Mitchell
County Georgia. I also will and desire that the above named
lots of land shall be divided equally between Son Robert H.
James & my daughter Margaret J. Gee and made
use of as they may think proper twelve or thirteen after the
ratification of Peace between the United States and the Confederate
States of America when it is to be appraised by three disinterested
persons and then the said Robert H., James & Margaret J.
Gee to divide it as they may think proper. I also recommend
desire that one fifth of the valuation of said lands be paid
over to the Children of John H. Lee One fifth to the Children of
William H.

Ninth
It is also my will and desire that all the personalty property
be disposed of at such times as the Executors may think
proper.

Tenth
I do nominate and appoint my Sons Robert H., James
& J., and my Son-in-law William H. Gee Executors of this my
last Will and Testament. I will and desire that in the execution
of their trust that they shall not be subject to any order or
decree of the Court of Ordinary or in any wise responsible therefor
In witness whereof I the Suber Wm. H. Gee have set my
hand and seal this the 12th day of December 1864
