the whole sum, jointly & severally, & firmly by these
presents.

Sealed with our seals, & dated this seventh day of October 1892.
The condition of the above obligation is such, that if
the above bound Jesse M. Purdy make a true &
perfect inventory of the goods, chattels, rights, credits, lands
and tenements of George Purdy, late of ——— County,
deceased, which have or shall come into the hands,
possession, or knowledge of the said Jesse M. Purdy
or the hands or possession of any person, or persons,
for him & the same so made to exhibit unto the said
Ordinary, when he shall be hereunto required; and
such goods, chattels, credits, lands, and tenements,
do well & truly administer, according to law, & do
make a just & true account of his actings & doings
therein, when he shall thereunto be required by the
court; Shall deliver & pay to such person, or persons
respectively, as they may be entitled to the same
by law: And if it shall hereafter appear that
any last Will & Testament was made by the
deceased, & the same be proven before the Court of
Ordinary, & the Executor obtain a certificate of
the probate thereof, & said Jesse M. Purdy in
such case, if required, render & deliver up the
said "Return of administration", then this Obligation
to be void, else to remain in full force.
