which shall or have come to the hands possession or knowledge
of the said W. F. Mallard or into the possession of any other person
for him and that same make an exhibit to the said Ordinary whom
he shall be thenceforth required and such goods Chattels Credits
do will and truly administer according to said and do make
a just and true account of his doings and doings thence
whom required by law and all the rest of the goods and
Credits which shall be found remaining upon the account
of the said Administrator the same being first made by
the said Ordinary shall deliver and pay to said person
respectfully as are entitled to the same by law and if it shall
hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made
by the said George Mallard and that be proven before the
Ordinary and the Executor obtain a Certificate thereof of the
Ordinary and the said W. F. Mallard do in such Cases if required
render and deliver up said Letters of Administration
then this bond to be void else of full force
