acknowledge ourselves jointly and severally bound unto
James L. Stewart Ordinary of said County, and his suc-
cessors and assigns, in the full and full sum of one
Thousand Dollars to the true payment of which well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and the heirs
and executors of us and each of us, jointly & severally, by
these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this
7th day of July 1873.

The condition of the above bond or obli-
gation is such, That if the above bound John S. Poore
was this day appointed Guardian of the person
and property of Mordock B. McLeod orphan
Child of George W. McLeod deceased he acknowledging
of the same by his acceptance of said appoint-
ment, and of letters of Guardianship of this date;
shall well and truly maintain, clothe, and educate
said orphan according to his circumstances, and
shall take good and lawful care of his person &
property, according to the Laws of this State, and
shall annually make a just & true return of all his
actings and doings herein, unto the said Ordinary
and pay over all assets that may remain in his
hands when said Guardianship shall legally
terminate, then this Obligation to be void, else
to remain in full force.
