Item 1st I will and bequeath to my wife Annabella
Francis during her life or widowhood all my Estate
real and personal for the benefit of herself and my
Children subject to the Conditions and limitations here-
in mentioned

Item 2nd As each of my Children shall reach the
age of twenty one years and in the case of the Girls when
they either come of age or marry I will that said Annabella
Francis shall give to each Child so coming of age or
marrying so much of my Estate not exceeding a Childs
part as can be spared from the support and maintenance
of herself and the remaining Children, of which she shall
be the sole judge ~~and~~ whenever she shall die or marry
again in case of her marrying again I will that the property
be divided between her and the Children then now then
alike, she taking a Childs part and in case of her death
before marriage I will that the property be divided equally
amongst the Children and whenever a final division
is made I direct that whatever property may have
been previously given off to any of the Children shall
be accounted for at its appraised value at the time
it was given off and all the property received by
said my Daughters under the Will shall be theirs
for their own benefit and behoof free from the
debts and contracts of their father herein as

Item 3rd If the said Anna Bella Francis shall at any time
during her widowhood think best for the benefit of the family
to alter the form of any property left by me at my death either by
exchange or by selling and reinvesting she shall have full
power to do so, according to her best judgment in the
premises

Item 4th I appoint my wife Annabella Francis
