Know all men by these presents,
That we, Jas H. Taylor, as principal, & A H. Leach &
M. A. Brown, securities, are held firmly
bound unto the Ordinary of said county, & his
successors in office, & assign, in the just
& full sum of Fifteen thousand dollars
for the payment of which sum to the said Ordinary
& his successors in office, we bind ourselves, our
heirs, executors, & administrators, in the whole & for the
whole sum, jointly & severally, & firmly by this present
Sealed with our seals & dated this 6th day of November 1871
The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the
above bound Jas H Taylor make a true & perfect
inventory of the goods, chattels, rights, credits, lands
& tenements of James H Brown late of Calhoun County
deceased, which have or shall come into the hands, possession
or knowledge of the said Jas H Taylor, or the hands or
possession of any person or persons, for him, and the
same so made to exhibit to the said Ordinary,
when he shall be therunto required, and such goods
chattels, credits, lands & tenements, do well & truly admin-
ister, according to law, & do make a just & true account
of his actings & doings therein, when he shall thereunto be
required by the Court, & shall deliver & pay to such person or persons
respectively, as they may be entitled to the same by law:
And if it shall here after appear that any cash bill &
receipt was made by the deceased, & the same be
proven before the Court of Ordinary, & the executor
obtain a certificate of the probate thereof, & the said
Jas H Taylor in such case, if required, render & deliver
up the said Letter of Administration, then the obligation
to be void, else to remain in full force.
