

Last Will and Testament of Jas Jones,

Georgia Mitchell County -

I Jas Jones of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament -

Item first - I give bequeath and devise to my son Geo Grover Jones the following property to wit: All of lot of land No (324) Three hundred and two city four except fifty (50) acres off of the North West Corner of said lot now owned by H. B. Dasher of said State and County said lot being in the 10th district of said County. All of lot of Land No Three hundred and two city five (325) in said District State and County. All of lot No. (326) Three hundred and two city six in said District State and County -

All of the interest I own in the four acres off of lot of Land No (326) Three hundred and six city four in the tenth (10) district of said State and County and bounded as follows - On the north by lands of Mr. Brimberry on the east by lands of said Brimberry on the south by lands of Geo. D. O'Leary on the west street or road running in front of residence -

All my house hold and Mitchell furniture all my watches jewelry Pistols and such other personal property that I may own not mentioned in this will -

All my stock in the Bank of Camilla amounting to ten undivided shares in said bank -

All of the five (5) shares of stock that I own in the Mitchell County Lumber Company all of the notes bonds drafts or other negotiable instruments that I may own at the time of my death -

All the stock that I may now own or may hereafter own in the Building and Loan and association of Atlanta

All my horses cattle wagons buggies plow tools and other farming implements all my sheep goats Hogs or other stock that I may own or in which I may have any interest -

All the mules that I may own or in which I may have any interest. It is my will that all the above property belong and the title rest in my son Geo. Grover Jones immediately after my death, But if he should die without a child or children then in that case the above described property be divided equally among my nieces and nephews -

Item Second - I give bequeath and devise to my three nephews Jas Jones Quinn Jones and R. M. Jones a thirty years estate in lot of land No (168) One hundred and sixty eight in the tenth (10th) district of said State and County after the death of Jas. Brimberry hundred and twenty five till the death of the last survivor of them.

But wither Jan 1st 1924 Nine Ten Hundred and Twenty four the title to said lot of land to revert to A. H. Jones provided said Union Jones or Russell Jones ~~provided said Union Jones or Russell Jones~~ should attempt to mortgage sell or in any way part with said lot of land No 168

Item Third - I give bequeath and devise to my brother William Jones the right to own and possess for thirty years from March the 9th 1894 all of lot of land No 162 one hundred and fifty two in the 10th district of said county said state after thirty years from Mar 9th 1894 title to vest absolutely in said William Jones. Before that time the title to be in A. H. Jones of said state and county

Item Fourth I give bequeath and devise to my son George Grover Jones all the interest I own in lots of land No 42 and 253 lot No 42 lying and being in the 10th district of Mitchell County Ga and lot no 253 lying and being in the 9th district of said county It is my will that all the land given to my son Geo. Grover Jones be held in trust for said George Grover Jones by my brother A. H. Jones wither my son becomes thirty (30) years of age

Item fifth - I here by constitute and appoint my brother A. H. Jones my father in law G. W. Swindle and brother in law D. B. Davis executors of this my last will and Testament This the 9th day of March 1894
