Know all men by these presents that we Ann, E. Davis principal, and Israel Maples & D.B. Davis securities, are held and firmly bound unto the Ordinary of said County and his successors in Office and assigns in the first and full sum of Four Thousand Dollars for the payment of which sum to the said Ordinary and his successors in Office, We bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors, and Administrators in the whole and for the whole sum jointly & severally and firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 9th day Feb'y 1874.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound Ann, E. Davis do make a true and perfect Inventory of the Goods, Chattels, Rights, Credits, Lands and Tenements, of Joshua C. Davis late of said County deceased, which have shall come into the hands possession or knowledge of the said Ann, E. Davis or the hands or possession of any person or persons for her, and the same so made to exhibit unto the said Ordinary, when she shall be hereunto required, and such goods Chattels Credits, Lands & Tenements, do well and truly administer according to Law, and do make a just & true account of her acting & doings therein when she shall thereunto be required by the Court, shall deliver & pay to such person or persons respectfully, as they may be entitled to the same by law, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will & Testament was made by the decedent, and the same be proven before the Court of Ordinary and the Executor obtained a certificate of the probate thereof, and Ann, E. Davis do in such case if required render & deliver up the said letters of Administration then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force & effect.
