The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above
said L. A. M. Collins make a true & perfect inventory of the
goods, chattels, rights, credits, lands & tenements of Lewis
G. Tyne, late of Mitchell County, deceased, which hereon
shall come into the hands, possession or knowledge of the
said L. A. M. Collins, or the hands or possession of any
person or persons for him, and the same do made to exhibit
unto the said Ordinary, when he shall be hereunto required: & such
goods, chattels, credits, lands & tenements, do well & truly
administer according to law & do make a true & just account
of his actings & doing therein when he shall thereunto be required by
the Court: & shall deliver & pay to such person or persons respectively
as they may be entitled to the same by law: And if it shall hereafter
appear that any wish & testament was made by the deceased
& the same shall be proven before the Court of Ordinary, & the
Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof, and to
the said L. A. M. Collins in such case, if required,
render & deliver up the said Letters of Administration, then
the Obligation to be void, else to remain in full force
