and severally bound unto James L. Stewart
Ordinary of said County & his successors in
Office & assigns in the just & full sum of
Eight hundred and sixty dollars & the
true payment of which well and truly to
be made, we bind ourselves and the heirs
and executors of us & each of us, jointly &
severally by these presents,
Sealed with our seals and dated this July
6th 1874

The condition of the above bond or obligation
is such, That if the above bound Eli Adams
who was this day appointed Guardian of the person
& property of Mary S. Adams Orphan Child of
Hansell Adams dec'd. in acknowledging of the same
by his acceptance of said appointment & of
Letters of Guardianship of this date, shall well and
truly maintain, clothe & educate said Orphan
according to her circumstances, and shall
take good & lawful care of her person & property
according to the laws of this state, & shall annually
make a just & true return of all his acting & doing
hereunto the said Ordinary, and pay over all
the assets that may remain in his hands when
said Guardianship shall legally terminate, then
this obligation to be void else to remain in
full force
