Ordinary of said County and his  
successors and assigns in the just  
and full sum of two hundred dollars  
to the true payment of which sum and  
truly to be made within ourselves  
and the heirs and executors of us and  
each of us jointly and severally by  
these presents. Given with our seals  
and dated this twenty-first day of  
March 1872.

The Condition of  
the Above bond or obligation is such  
that if the Above bound H. C. Cannon,  
H. C. Cannon who was this day  
appointed guardian of the person  
and property of Mary H. Cannon  
orphan child of Elizabeth H.  
Cannon deceased, acknowledging  
of the same by his acceptance of said appointment  
and attestation of guardianship of this date shall and  
truly maintain, clothe and educate said  
orphan according to her circumstances and  
shall take good and lawful care of her person and  
property according to the laws of this State and  
shall annually make a just and true return  
of all his doings and things herein unto  
the said ordinary and pay over all assets  
that may remain in his hands when said  
guardianship may legally terminate then  
this obligation to be void else to remain in full  
force.
