lands & tenements of Mary G. Walker late of
said County. decd. which have or shall come
into the hands, possession, or knowledge of the
said William Spence or the hands or posses-
sion of any person or persons for him
and the same, so made to exhibit unto
the Ordinary when he shall be hereunto
required; & such goods, chattels, credits lands &
tenements do well & truly administer, according
to law and do make a just & true account
of his acts & doings therein when he shall thereunto
be required by the Court: shall deliver & pay
to such person or persons, respectfully as they
may be entitled to the same by law.

And if it shall hereafter appear that
any last Will & Testament was made by
