his successors and assigns in the just &
full sum of four thousand dollars
to the true payment of which well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves
& the heirs & Executors of us and each of
us jointly & severally, by these presents
sealed with our seals and dated this the
25th day of April 1873-

The condition of the above Bond or oblig-
ation is such that if the above bonded George
W. McElveen who was on July 15th 1870
appointed Trustee of the persons and property
of Margaret D. & J. B. McElveen by James McElveen
J. S. C. of S. W. G. Georgia- orphan Children of R. D.
& M. E. McElveen decd who acknowledging the same
by his acceptance of his appointment and
his appointment of Trustee of this date.
shall well and truly maintain, clothe
& educate said Orphans according to
their Circumstances, and shall take good
& lawful care of their persons and property
according to the laws of this state & shall
annually make a just & true return of all
his actings & doings therein, unto the said
Ordinary & pay over all assets that may
remain in his hands - when said Trust-
eeship shall legally terminate then
this obligation to be void, else to
remain in full force
