Of a Note I hold against Dr J. B. Smith I give to him in dependant of whatever there may be in North Carolina of my Estate either in realty or Personal, All of which Personal Property in said State, of whatever shape or Character, I desire sold and the Money equally divided among all of my Children as above named. Having only a life Estate in the Land belonging to my Estate I can make neither devise to make any distribution of it other than the law makes provides, In order that this my last Will & Testament as above set forth may be carried out I appoint & constitute G. B. Blake my son of Anson County North Carolina, and Dr J. B. Smith of this County, Executors for the aforesaid purposes.
