The condition of the above bond or obligation is such, that
that if the above bound William Spence who was this
day appointed Guardian of the person and property
of Robert, C. Walliburton Orphan Child of Thomas
C. Walliburton deceased he acknowledging of
the same by his acceptance of said appointment,
and of Letters of Guardianship of this date; shall
well and truly maintain, clothe and educate said
Orphan according to his circumstances, and shall take
good and lawful care of his person and property
according to the laws of this State, and shall
annually make a just & true return of all his
actings and doings herein, unto the said Ordinary
and pay over all assets that may remain in
his hands when said Guardianship shall legally
terminate, then this Obligation to be void else
