I Sarah E Ward of the county of mitchell & state of Georgia being of sound & disposing mind hereby do make this my last will & Testament

1st I give bequeath & devise to my daughter Joseph Le Roy Ward the following property first my undivided half interest in all the lands in the county of Madison owned by and in the state of Florida owned by Joseph Le Roy Griffin the Father of my said daughter Joseph Le Roy Ward at the time of his death the same being all of the land in said county of Madison and state of Florida as on which I own an interest to her own proper use benefit & enjoyment in fee simple

2nd I give bequeath & devise to my son John Henry Pearson one (100) hundred acres of land in the north west corner of lot of land no forty nine (49) in the eleventh (11) dist of mitchell county & as the same being the northern part of the hundred & fifty acres which I own on the west side of said lot cut off from the other part of said one hundred & 50 acres by all east & west being parallel to the northern boundary line of said lot to his own property for benefit & use and to own in fee simple

3^d I give bequeath & devise to my daughter Mattie A Ward fifty (50) acres of land in the south west corner of lot of land no forty nine (49) in the eleventh (11) dist of the county of mitchell and state of Ga the same being the southern part of the one hundred and fifty acres of land which I own on the west side of said lot of land no forty (49) nine including the house & premises on which I now live and cut off from the northern part of said one hundred & fifty acres by on east and west line to her own proper use benefit and enjoyment in fee simple

4th I desire & will that after paying my just debts all of my other personal property not here before mentioned & disposed of and which is now own at my death to be divided in kind among my three children Joseph Le Roy Ward John Henry Pearson and Mattie A Ward equally share and share alike as nearly as the nature of the property will permit

5th I here by declare and appoint my husband John M Ward
executor of this my last will and testament this the
5th day of November 1890 Sarah E Ward
