1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent
and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and
Condition in life, My soul I trust shall return to rest with
God who gave it as I hope for Salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus
Christ,

2^d Secondly, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executors herein after named and
appointed,

3^d Thirdly, I give and bequeath and devise to my beloved
wife Merriam Sellers all of the rest of my Estate, both
real and personal with all the rights members and appur-
tenances in any wise appertaining belonging free from
all Charges and Limitations, whatever, to her own pro-
use and benefit so long as she shall live or during her
widowhood, and at her death the remainder of my property
to be sold and equally divided between the rest of my
Heirs at Law,

4th Fourthly - I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Merriam Sellers and my youngest Son William
I Sellers Executors of this my last Will and Testament

an inventory be taken of all my household & kitchen
furniture be taken as soon as it can be done
after my death, and for my wife Elizabeth to give
my Executors J. L. Stewart and J. L. Stewart a receipt from
her for the full coming of my household &
kitchen furniture at the death.
