

Georgia 3 Now all men by these presents that of
Abund County 3 Abund Lockett of the County and
State aforesaid, being in the possession of a sound mind
and sober mind & memory have constituted ordained and
appointed, and by these presents do constitute ordain and
appoint this to be my last will & Testament in manner &
form following to wit,

Item 1st I give to my wife Paddy Lockett one negro woman
named Patsy her child, & also my gill & grey horse to
her & to the the heirs of the body forever and during the
term of natural life or widowhood to be maintained out
of the proceeds of my estate so far as may be necessary
in conjunction with her own property for that purpose
Also all the children who are minors to be maintained
and educated until they arrive to the several ages hereafter
mentioned

Item 2nd I give to my son David Lockett when he arrives
to the age of Twenty years, one Negro Fellow named Gab this
I will give him if he be alive if not his value in money. Also
Twenty human a dollar in money one yoke of broke or unbroke
Sters, Two Cows & Calves 4 head of sheep fifteen head of hogs
including Sows & pigs and one bed & Furniture to him his
heirs and assigns forever

Item 3rd I give to my son Abund Lockett when he arrives to
the age of Twenty years one Negro woman named Jacob if he
be then alive, if not his value in money. Also four human
a dollar in money, one horse broke & saddle to be worth
one human a & fifty dollars, one yoke of broke or unbroke
Sters, Two Cows & Calves 4 head of sheep 15 head of hogs including
Sows and pigs and one bed & Furniture to him his heirs and assigns
forever

Item 4th I give to my son Solomon Lockett, when he arrives
to the age of Twenty years one negro named Sam if he
be then alive if not his value in money. Also human
a dollar in money one horse broke & saddle to be
worth one human a & fifty dollars, one yoke of broke or unbroke
Sters, Two Cows & Calves 4 head of sheep 15 head of hogs
including Sows & pigs and one bed & Furniture to him
his heirs and assigns forever

Item 5th I give to my daughter Polly Barrow one Negro
Fellow named Natha Math for by her to her on the first
day of January 1829 and one Negro boy between 12 & 18
years old to be purchased for her as soon as the

Money can be raised from the crops of the estate, to her
to take her only of her Body and if she dies without
Issue or the her a heir of her Body dies intestate I wish
her The property to revert back to my estate and to be equally
Divided among my children.

Item 6 I give to my daughter Martha Lockett, when she
arrives to the age of twenty years the following negroes, Bill May
& Aggy if they be alive if not the value of the deceased ones
in money, also for him one dollar in money one horse Bridle
& Saddle to be worth one hundred and fifty dollars Two cows
valued in value of sheep 15 head of hogs including Sows & pig
and one Bed & Furniture to her & to the heirs of her Body.

Item 7 I give to my Son Hugh Lockett the value in money
of a certain Negro fellow named Calup (noticed) his Title
is not a valid to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item 8 The Balance of my Estate, after paying the above
and foregoing Legacies and a maintenance for my wife during
her natural life and widowhood to be equally divided between
my four Sons James, Hugh, David, & Solomon Lockett
and my daughter Martha Lockett, when my Son Solomon
arrives to the age of Twenty years to them and their heirs
and assigns forever.

Item 9 I do constitute and appoint my Sons James, Hugh,
and David Lockett Executors to this my last will & Testament
and do hereby authorize & empower them to manage my
Estate in such way and manner as they in their judgment
may conceive to be most conducive to the interest of
my Estate and best calculated to enable them to carry
into completely effect the above said will I am witness
whereof I have set my hand and seal, this
