hold or may hereafter come to me as my dividend of the Estate
of Wm M Elder deceased, by late Husband, after so much
of the personal property is sold as will pay my debts I
will I bequeath to my Children, to wit Frances H, Martha
Ann, Arthur Jackson, Mary Ann, William & Marion, Harriet
Braxton, John Wesley, and Wilmoth Claiborne Elder to be
equally divided between my said Children when the
youngest shall become of free age.

I hereby constitute make and appoint my worthy friend
James H McFievin my lawful Executor to carry into
effect this my last will and Testament

It is also my request that my Children should be kept
together on my present farm or place of residence and
I do hereby give my Executor with discretionary powers
with regard to my property to carry out last request
into Execution. In witness whereof I the said Catharine
Elder have hereunto set my hand and seal this the
