Monroe My Wright being afflicted in body but of strong
mind and memory do make ~~this~~ constitute this my last
Will and Testament. As Wit
The whole of my property both personal & real I
leave to my wife & Children to be equally divided
among them in following manner. It is my wish
that all the property be kept together on the pre-
mises where I now live until the youngest child
be come of age when the oldest child be come of
lawful age wish that an equal share may be
divided from the common stock of property and
given to it and like manner with my other children
as they be come of age until it is all equally
divided, that is an equal part for each child and one
for my wife. But I wish it distinctly understood that
the land and premises where on I reside is not to be
taken into consideration in my division that may take
place until my youngest child be come of age at
which time I wish that it be equally divided between
my wife and children. Should my wife again marry
before my youngest child be come of lawful age I wish
that her proportionable part, that is, a share equal
with one of the children be divided off to her as
soon as she may demand it or when the property
and crop if then should be on growing will suit
her. I wish all my just debts paid as early
as possible and if my present crop should not
be sufficient I wish my executors to sell any of
my personal property that they may think advisable
for that purpose or a lot of Land I own in
Maricotta County or such terms as they may think
advantageous. If at any time my Executors should
deem it for the interest of my family to make sale
of the premises where on I live they are authorized to do so
And I do hereby authorize my Executors to do so
in all cases as they may think most advisable
for the interest of the family or as I would do
were I personally present.
I do hereby appoint my friends William Shilbuck &
John Greer Executors and my wife Martha L. Wright
Executrix to carry this my last will & Testament
into effect in witness where of I do hereunto
