

Georgia 3 In the name of God Amen.
Monroe County } I, David Hunter of the State
and County aforesaid being weak in body but
sound in mind, but calling to remembrance
that it is appointed by God for all men to die,
do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament in the ~~name of~~ manner and form
following hereby revoking all others. First of all
I resign my soul to God who gave it and my body
to the grave to be buried in a Christian like manner at
the discretion of my Executors nothing doth but that it
will be raised at the resurrection and as for the property
where with God has been pleased to bless me with, I do
dispose of in the following manner;

Item 1st I will and bequeath unto my son James Hunter
the land whereon he now lives, also a Negro Woman
named Paty, about twenty four years of age, one
black and brown Coverlet.

Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my daughter
Margaret Lavina Champion, one Negro Woman
named Mary, about twenty nine years of age
also a Negro Girl about two years of age
named Jane, and their increase, and ~~be a~~ ~~bed~~
stead and furniture also, one loom and ~~two~~, one
black and brown Coverlet, one fine Table, also
a Cow and Calf which they have, have now
in their possession and one breeding Slap to her and
the heirs of her body, for ever.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my son David
Hunt one Negro man named Jack
about twenty five years of age, and a shot Gun, and
a Cow & Calf, & a Red Bedstead & furniture, and one black
and brown Coverlet, one Haymower, bridle &
saddle, and old rake of Oxen,

Item 4th I will and bequeath to my son Abraham
Hunter, one Negro Boy, Charles, about nine
years of age, a Negro Girl named Fanny, one
Rifle Gun one Red Bedstead and furniture
also one Red and yellow Blanket or Coverlet.

also One Cow & Calf and the Sock of young ones, &
young parrots more,

And I will and bequeath to my son Abel B. Hunt
-ter, one Negro Boy named Lewis about fourteen years
of age, and other negro Boy, Joe, also my Horse and
one Saddle Colt, one Cow & Calf, and all my stock of Cat-
-the not given away, one Chest of Drawers, one fine Slab,
and Slab ware, one large Looking Glass, one Walnut
Table and all my Job and Kitchen Furniture and Plan-
tation Tools, One Bed & Furniture, One Brown Coated
Straw Hat. The Land and Plantation whereon I now live
it is my will bequeath that it shall remain in the possession
of ~~my~~ my three for their use and support until my
youngest son shall arrive to the age of twenty one years
and then to be equally divided among them in any
way they may think proper, so that each shall have
his full proportion, it is also my will and desire that
my youngest son be educated out of the products of the
plantation, It is also my will that my stock of sheep
be equally divided among my five above named
children, the stock of Hogs, it is my will be given to
my three youngest children, I give and bequeath, that
all my ready money, all debts due me and all
my Great Crop, after paying my last debts be equal-
-ly divided among my three youngest children.
All whatever of my property not given away, it my will
may divided or remain among my three youngest
children.

And lastly I constitute and appoint
James Moffett my Executor to execute this
My last will and Testament, In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal, this 19th nineteenth day of April 1841
-two hundred and Thirty One, Signed sealed in
