

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF REBECCA HARMAN

Recorded 8-5-1830, Monroe County, Ga.

In the name of God, Amen.

I, Rebecha Harman of the County of Monroe and State of Georgia, do make and publish this as my last will and testament in manner and form as follows; To-wit,

In the first place I request that all my just debts be paid.

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Evans my negro Rosamiah and her children, Chloe and Cymantha.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Clark, my negro girl, Priscilla.

Fourthly, I will and bequeath to William M. Harman one bed one white sow and pigs and a young heifer I now have.

Fifthly, I hereby confirm a gift heretofore made of my negroes Elija and Abram to the children of my son Zackariah Harman and his wife Harriett Harman.

Sixthly, All the rest and residue of my property I hereby give and bequeath to my son Zachariah Harman. I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Zachariah Harman my sole executor to see to the fully carrying into effect the above bequest.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this third day of Feby., in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty.
