concerns.

I therefore give (and bequeath unto my wife Mary Low all my
property that I possess after paying all my just debts to her heirs
(and owned by her (and for her use during her natural life or
widowhood to enable her to raise (and educate my children.

I further direct that she (Mary Low) shall keep the property
all together, except the stiles (and some of the stock hogs such as
the family can best spare which I will to be sold at my
death - And at her (Mary Low's) death or marriage, the
property then belonging to my estate shall be equally divided
among my children (and my widow.

In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand (and seal
this twenty first day of December in the year of our Lord
eighteen hundred (and thirty, two

William, after being duly sworn make oath (and) say that they saw
James Low sign, seal (and) acknowledge the same as (and) for his last will
(and) testament (and) that they in the presence of the (and) James Low (and) at his
request (and) in the presence of each other (and) of Alexander Russell, signed the
same as attesting, witnesses (and) that they saw Alexander Russell in the pres-
ence of (and) Low (and) at his request sign the same as an attesting
witness with these deponents, (and) that at the time of the execution of said
last will (and) testament the (and) James Low was of sound (and) disposing
mind (and) memory.
