(and owned by her and for her use during her natural life or
widowhood to enable her to raise (and educate my children.

I further direct that she (Mary Low) shall keep the property
all together, except the stillo (and some of the stock hogs such as
the family can best spare which I will to be sold at my
death - And at her (Mary Low's) death or marriage, the
property then belonging to my estate shall be equally divided
among my children (and my widow.

this twenty first day of December in the year of our Lord
eighteen hundred and thirty two
