Monroe County } In the name of God, Amen.

I Jesse Clover being in proper
mind and memory, thank'd be to God for the same, Calling
to mind the mortality of my Body, knowing that it is appointed
for all men to die, do make and ordain this my last will
and Testament, That is to say first of all, I recommend
my soul to God that gave it, and my body I recom-
mend my soul to God to the Earth to be buried in a decent
Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors,
Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the power of the Almighty
God, And as touch such worldly Estate as it has pleased
God to bless me with in this life, I give devise and bequeath
-th of the same in the following manner viz

1st I do make appoint and ordain my wife Matilda
Clover my Executrix and my son John H. Clover my
Executor to carry this my last will and Testament
into effect, — 2nd I will and bequeath that
my ~~two~~ said Executors sell all my lands that lie
out of Monroe County, to the best advantage as
they think proper and after all my ^(just) debts be paid
the residue to be loaned or placed to the best advantage
3rd I will and bequeath that all the balance of my
Estate be kept together until some of my children
become of age or marry and when any one of
those my children become of age or marry to have
their equal part of my Estate at such time and
so to be divided until my youngest child become
of age or married —

4th I will and bequeath that my wife Ma-
tilda Clover have her equal part with my
children that is to say a child's part of my
Estate during her natural life or widowhood
and in case of her death her part to be equally
divided among my four children and in case
she should marry, her part to return to my children
at the time of her marriage and her to draw five
hundred dollars out of my Estate, and her
Executorship to cease, at that time, and that to be
all that shall be necessary.
