3rd I wish my property kept together in the best manner possible, (and my children raised on it or the profits of it until my eldest child comes of age or marries, then that the same may be divided so as to give her an equal share with the rest of my children (and my beloved wife, (and so on as the rest of my children comes of age or marries for them to have their equal share in the same manner as the first.

4. I constitute (and appoint my beloved wife Jane Greer (and my friend John Powell executrix (and executor to carry this will into effect Signed, sealed, published (and declared this 22nd September 1834
