said also I will my Beloved Wife Martha Hoams  
One Negro man by the name of Sam and Negro Girl  
the name of Esther and one Negro boy the name of Peter  
to her During her natural life and also the horses and  
Stock cattle and Stock of Hogs and Sheep to have  
all this property during her Widowhood I also will my  
Daughter Ginny Rame the Wife of Edmund Ramey  
five Dollars to her at the distribution of my property  
and Equal Division among the rest of my heirs in Witness  
Whereof I have set my hand and Affixed my Seal this  
the 21<sup>st</sup> April 1823
