which negro woman I will shall be her part of my estate

Third - I give ~~and~~ bequeath unto my three Sons (aforementioned) John S Woodward
Brown H Woodward and Green S Woodward all the remainder of my Prop-
erty and effects which belongs to my estate -- to be equally divided
among them.

Fourth - I will ~~and~~ do hereby appoint my three sons John S Woodward Brown
H Woodward and S Woodward as Executors to this my last will ~~and~~
and Testament.
