estate as it has pleased God to bestow upon me in this life, I give
devise bequeath of the same in the following manner (Viz)
1st I give and bequeath that all my just debt be paid
2nd I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary Haines my town my riding horse
and also I give unto my daughter Mary Haines all my wearing
clothes & spinning wheel and Card. also her selling & aving forever.
3rd I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Elizabeth Heyerd
daughter of my son John Heyerd. my best bedstead & furniture
and her painted pine chest. forever.
4th I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Mary Ann
Mines daughter of my son John Mines my side saddle forever
5th I give and bequeath unto my son John Mines children a fifty
one dollar and twenty cent note that I hold on the said
John Mines estate and two twenty dollar notes I hold on John
Haines also one ten dollar note I hold on John Mines with the
exception that all my just debts be paid out of said notes
6th I will and bequeath that my negro girl Charity my standing
table & five dogs be sold to the best advantage and the money
loaned out for interest untill my son John Mines young let
child become twenty one years of age and then to be equally
divided am ong my said son John Mines child and
7th I have two acres in the present Contemplative Land Lottery, Viz. One
in the land and one in the gold regions if I should be a fortunate
drawer I will and bequeath that they be sold and equally divided
am ong my child and my son John Mines my son Thomas
Mines my son William and also my daughter Mary Haines
my daughter Prilla and also the children of my son John
Mines
8th I do make appoint and ordain Moses Harris my Executor to
carry this my last will and testament into effect,
whereof I have in witness hereunto my hand and seal this 1st
