make, ordain, constitute and appoint this to be my
last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other
and former Wills by me made.

Item 1st I give and bequeath to Robert Freeman, Pamela
Freeman, Edy Winkfield Freeman, Eveline Augustus
Freeman, Henry Freeman, Arrabella Howard Freeman,
& John Forsyth Freeman, one whole lot of land
No 28 in the fifth district Monroe County (it being
the place where on I now live) and my will
is that Robertson Freeman have charge of and
control of it for the mutual support of himself
and support of his and raising of his afore nam-
ed brothers and sisters, and that they also for
the same purpose have all the stocks not herein
after given or otherwise disposed of, and my will
is that Arrabella Freeman have the best
Bed, Two figured Counterpane a white Counter-
pane worked with white, two checked Coun-
terpane, Three of the best bed quilts, and I do
hereby give and bequeath the same unto
her, I also give and bequeath unto Robert-
son Freeman one Bed and Furniture, I
also give and bequeath unto Edy Winkfield
Freeman one Bed and Furniture, also I
give and bequeath unto Eveline Augustus
Freeman one Bed and Furniture, I also
give and bequeath unto Arrabella Freeman
one white Trunk and one Bed and
two pair of Sheets, I also give and bequeath
the unto Arrabella Freeman one Horse
Coll, and I hereby give and bequeath
all the rest and residue of the House-
hold and Kitchen Furniture unto the
afore named Persons for their mutual
support, and my wish is that Pamela
Freeman have the privilege of making her-
self a Bed from the Cate that are on the
premises, my will and desire is that

brothers and sisters and I also give and bequath
with Annabella J Freeman and one Negro Woman called
Manny and the first child that (being my)
hereafter have to say W. Freeman.

Now Ind my Will and desire is that after my
decease the Lot of Land in Butts County, which
was willed to me by my husband, say Lot
No. 9 in the first district originally Henry
now Butts and spoke of Aaron and Carl. One
Forre Horse ^(in Jan) Negro Woman Sally, Malinda
& Cassie be and the proceeds equally divided
between Sally Arnold, formerly Freeman, Eliza-
beth, formerly Freeman and Theolotta Freeman
Daughters of Throvel Freeman and to them
I hereby give and bequath the same, and
all the rest and residue of my Property,
not herein before disposed of be all sold
as above and also equally divided amongst
the last named persons to wit, Sally
Elizabeth Martha and Theolotta, after the
payment of the debts and cash legacies.

Now Ind my Will and desire is that my neigh-
bors, Collier Foster and Henry ~~Freeman~~
Salmond be and they are hereby appoint-
ed, my Executors to carry this my last
Will and Testament into execution, In
witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 8th day of February 1832,
