 make this my last Will and testament.

First my body to be decently buried - and as for such property as
 it has been please God to bless me with I wish my sons Martin and
 Warren W Edge to take my negro woman Fanny and her children
 Antony and Lonisa and all of her increase and put it to the use of my
 daughter Mary Folds another child. The said negroes being at the
 time I first loaned the woman to my daughter in value to that
 I gave to my sons Martin, Garland Simpson & Warren W Edge at the
 time they left me - And my will is that my wife Hely Edge shall
 have her maintenance out of the balance of my property and all the
 balance of said property both real and personal be equally divided into
 five parts Martin Edge to have one, Garland Edge to have one,
 Simpson Edge one, Warren W Edge one, and the other part to go
 into the hands of Martin and Warren W Edge for the use of my
 daughter Mary and her children, and it is my will that William
 Folds is never to have any control of any of my property in any
 manner whatever, nor is it to be ever subject to his debts or control
 or to support him in any manner whatever and it is my will
 and desire that if my daughter is ever separated from the said
 William Folds by his death or otherwise so that he cannot have
 any control of her property, then the above named negroes and the
 fifth part of the other property is to be given up to her ~~own~~
~~own~~ property - and it is my will that my sons Martin, Garland
 Simpson and Warren W Edge shall have equal right to ~~inherit~~
 my property except as above Relative to my daughters part which
 is to be managed as above stated.

and memory do make, publish and declare this my last
and Testament in manner and form following. That is to say,
1st I will that my just debts be paid by my Executors hereinafter
named out of such funds or property as they may think fit
and proper.

2nd I will and bequeath unto my sons Dickie M Collier and Mar-
lin T Collier an equal share each of all my property and
effects except my land of which or the proceeds of which they are
to receive no part whatever

3rd I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Rebecca and my
Children Sarah West, John T Collier, Pleasant Collier, Benjamin
Collier, Elizabeth Collier, Robert Collier and James Collier
and to any other child or children that I may hereafter have
born all my land of which I may be seized and possessed to be
equally divided between them share and share alike hereinafter
to be sold as hereinafter directed, and if then land should be purchas-
ed such land to be equally divided among my wife and children
in this Clause mentioned, and I further will and bequeath to my
wife and children herein mentioned an equal share each of
all the residue of my property with my son Dickie M Collier
Marlin T Collier and as my sons Dickie M and Marlin T Collier
and my Daughter Sarah West have each received a bed and fur-
niture, I will that each of my other children receive a bed
and furniture so as to make them all equal, and as my Daughter
Sarah West has received a negro woman by this name
of the value of one thousand dollars and a mare of the value
of one hundred dollars and a cow of the value of one hundred
