& manner as they may conceive most expedient to the
interest of said estate For the benefit and support
of my Grandmother Ailey Waulkin during her natural
life and also for the benefit & support of my wife
Nancy Waulkin and for the support maintenance
& education of my children during the natural life
a widowhood of my said wife Nancy and at
her death or marriage the property to be equally
divided among my surviving children and their heirs
I do hereby constitute ordain and appoint Ziba
Fletcher & James Lovett Executors to this my last
will & Testament In witness whereof I place hereunto
my hand & seal this the 16th day of Decr 1839—
