this my last will and testament, in manner and form
following, first I resign my soul into the hands of
Almighty God, trusting and believing in A Remission of
my sins by the merits and satisfaction of Jesus Christ.
And my body I command to the Earth to be buried
at the discretion of my friends, And my worldly
Estate I give and devise as follows.

1st I give and bequeath to my younger son Rich-
ard Wallace all that tract of ~~land~~ or parcel of
Land whereon I now live known and distinguished
in plan of survey by lot No. Eighty-eight in the twel-
fth district to have and to hold to my said son
Richard Wallace his heirs and assigns for ever
together with the present crop now in the said
premises together with all the plantation tools
house hold & kitchen furniture together with the
Horses and Cattle and stock of all description
belonging to said premises.

2nd I also give to my younger son Rich-
ard Wallace five Negroes to wit Sarah Ben-
Nagy, Harriet Randal Venus Stephen Cage, Jack-
son, provided that the said Richard Wallace
pay out of the said legacy to my two sons
William Wallace and David Wallace the
following sums to wit

3rd To William Wallace the sum of four
Hundred dollars to be paid within four years
after my decease,

4th To David Wallace the sum of One
Hundred Dollars to be paid within four years after
my decease.

5th I also require out of my Estate be-
-ueath to my younger son Richard, that he
pay to each of the Wives of my Legacies to wit
Pepe & John Wallace Elizabeth Gullage Pety
-Dick Sally Gaddy & Nancy Gaddy the
sum of one dollar to each of them with-
-in four years after my decease.

6th And finally all the Rest Residue and
remainder of my Estate and affects
Real and personal what-soever and where-
-ever
