that it is my duty while in life and of sound mind & disposing mind
to make such a disposition of my property and effects as I desire to
effect after my death do make and ordain the following to be my
Last Will and Testament. Herby revoking all others by me made at any
time. To wit.

1st I nominate and by this will appoint my brother James Birns
Executor and my wife Executrix to this will

2^d I will that all my just debts be paid

3^r I will that first of all after my debts are paid including
Charges that the sum of Twenty five hundred dollars be applied
and set apart for the purpose of Educating my Children

4th I will that my Executor and Executrix keep all my property
unless my wife should die or get married if she die the property
at her death between my children then living share and share alike
or if she marry then the property to be divided between her and
children then living share and share alike.

5 I am Guardian for two Wests Orphans of Ebenezer W. Hammond
at his death I wish the Court of Ordinary in the proper County to appoint
proper Guardian for each of them taking bond & security for
the faithful performance of said Guardianship.

Nathaniel G. Slaughter and Amos W. Hammond who have
been to witness this my will on the 31st day of July 1847 and

2nd It is my will that a note I hold against John A Dillard for two
hundred and thirty nine dollars be given to him and that with
