Monroe whereon I now live my Negro, Diash, Gracey &
ally. also five Cows & calves my stock & hogs two horses and
my house hold and kitchen furniture and my plan-
tation tools.. for and during her natural life
2nd I give and bequeath unto my son George Dyff
my bay Colt. Commonly call^d. Georgeys for ever..
3rd It is my will and desire that my children Elizabeth
Thomas George & Christopher. Shall have at my Wifes
Death. the five ~~largest~~ calves together with their incre-
ase.. to be equally divided between them & share alike
for ever. I give unto my two sons Aquileia & William
One horse Each.. also two Cows & calves which they have
Received for ever.. also I give unto my daughter Elizabeth
One Cow & heifer commonly call^d. hns for ever. And at my
Wifes death it is my will and desire that she
shall have a horse saddle & Bridle to be raised
out of my Estate also one feather Bed Bedstead and
Furniture. I give and bequeath unto my son
Aquileia Dyff one feather Bed Bedstead & furniture
which he has received also I give & bequeath unto my
sons William. George. Thomas & Christopher one feather
Bed Bedstead & furniture Each at my Wifes Death or at
his discretion when convenient. as my Estate not
mentioned in this will heretofore. Except my land which
it is my will shall remain in the plantation my Wifes
lifetime shall be sold on Twelve Months Credit and
the money arising there from to be appropriated
to schooling Thomas. George & Christopher my three
youngest sons.. & it is further my will and desire
that after my Wifes death all my property together
with the increase shall be sold.. and after dis-
-charging the above bequest. the remainder shall be

a like

I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife
Mary Dypp and my son William Dypp my Executors
to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
and annulling all other Executions & Wills previously
made by me, constituting and ordaining this only as
