of hours be valued by Parkam Brackins and Daniel Ponder and if Anthony Boyart will pay the valuation to have my half of said lot ^{and} if not to be sold to the highest bidder in the town of Forsyth so quick as it can be sold & the money to be retained in the hands of my executors for further distribution as will be further desired.

I do I will that my lot of land two hundred and four in the fourth district formerly Hixsey now Fayette county be sold on the first Tuesday in January next at the court house when it has also one forty acre lot that I have in the Leavenworth country section and number not recollect'd to be sold as soon thereafter as it can, also one lot of land containing one hundred and forty acres the section and number not known to be sold as quick as convenient and the proceeds to be placed in the hands of my executors and all the money arising from my aforesaid lands to be handed out to the best advantage for the purpose of schooling and raising of my children and for further distribution.

I do I will that the lands wherein I now live remain in the hands of my wife Elizabeth Rogers during her natural life or widowhood or until my youngest child becomes of age, also all my negroes and other property not disposed of to remain on the plantation until my youngest child becomes of age ^{and} then to be sold and the proceeds with all the money that is theretofore named to be equally divided among my wife Elizabeth Rogers and my children namely Elanor Ann Edmund Rogers, Mary Ann Susan Rogers, John Richard Rogers, William Malins Rogers, James Anthony Rogers and Lucy Anne Rogers provided nevertheless if my wife Elizabeth Rogers should marry before my youngest child becomes of age I will that all my estate be valued and she to receive her full equal part out of my estate and her executrix to care and guardians appointed for my children & I do make appoint and ordain my wife Elizabeth Rogers my executrix and Elizabeth Ayres and my Father John Rogers my executors to carry this my last will and testament into effect.
