 first. after all my just debts are satisfied I give &
 bequeath to my beloved sister Rebecca Culloden the wife
 of Benjamin Eger the one half of my property and
 in the event of her decease to be equally divided among
 her children except that which has hereafter named
 second. I give and bequeath the other half of my
 Estate to Andrew English the son of my sister Lurima
 Culloden alias English except that which is hereafter
 named.

Thirdly, I dispose of my negro woman Rachel
 & girl and that when he allowed to him their time
 at fifteen dollars for & annuities under the direction
 of my executor. I appoint Wm. H. Pritchard and
 Arthur Egan my executor this 3rd day of Feb 1855
