I do make & declare this my last will & Testament
in manner & in form following: First I resign my soul into
the hands of Almighty God hoping & believing in a re-
mission of My sins by the merits & mediation of Jesus
Christ and my Body I commit to the Earth to be buried
at the discretion of my Executors, herein After mentioned.
And my word & estate I give & devise as follows: Unto my
six sons (Namely) James, David, Francis, Samuel, William
Ira, Als my three Daughters (Namely) Ann Jameson,
Sarah & Polly I give an equal share of all my Estate
and Effects, Real & personal whatsoever & Wheresoever,
not herein before otherwise effectually disposed of.
I give & devise unto my two sons (Namely) Samuel &
William Ira Nunn, Five hundred Dollars a piece over
and above their equal share with the above na-
med children, for the purpose of their Education
& raising &c

I do hereby appoint my two
sons James, & David Nunn, Executors of this
my last will & Testament Signed, sealed, published
and declared by the said Testator as and for his last
will and Testament, in presence of us, who at
his request in his presence and in the presence
of each other, have subscribed our names as wit-
nesses thereunto July 19th 1820

I bequeath this my last will and Testament.

Item 1st I will bequeath that my lands on which I now
live be divided into three equal parts to wit one third
to be given to my wife Susan Curry & one third to each
of my daughters Mary Jane & Martha Ann Curry my other
tract of Land lying in the 12th District Union County

No 379 I wish to be sold & the Money arising from the
sale of the land to be loaned out on Interest with
good security & the Money to be equally divided between my
two daughters when they become of age. Item 2nd I will
I bequeath that my two negroes Arthur & Easter be sold
& that two thirds of the Money arising from their sale
be also loaned out on Interest for the use of my two
daughters which is to be equally divided, & the oth-
er one third to be paid to my wife Susan Curry

Item 3rd I will I bequeath, that my Waggon & my Still
together with my crop after reserving enough for
the maintenance of my family & support of my farm,
be sold & the Money arising from the sale to go to
the discharge of my just debts & the balance if any,
to be loaned out on Interest for the benefit of
my two daughters. Item 4th I will I bequeath, that
all my household & kitchen furniture together with my
horses & cattle & hogs & plantation tools all remain on the
plantation for the use and benefit of my wife & daughter
Item 5th I will I bequeath that my friend and

Father in law Leonard Sims, will as soon as ³
convenient take the necessary steps to collect from
John Huddleston the Money due me from the sale of
my Father's Estate & that when collected he shall proceed
to loan it out on Interest & when my daughters become
of age to be equally divided between them, Ilem & Thelma
& bequeath, that my friend & Father in law Leonard Sims is
hereby appointed my lawful Executor & my wife Susan
Curry my Executrix. In witness I have this day set
my hand seal. May 17th. 1824
