I Zachariah B Harman of the County & state aforesaid being of feeble health but of sound (and) disposing mind & memory, & calling to mind the uncertainty of life (and) the certainty of death, & being anxious to make some particular disposition of the estate it has pleased a kind Providence to bless me with, do make, publish (and) ordain this my last will & testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made, & first of all I give my soul to my Creator who gave it & my body to be decently interred, as may be suit able to the wishes of my family.

Item first, It is my will (and) desire that my just debt be paid out of my estate by any Executor as early as practicable after my decease.

Item second, I give to my beloved wife Harriet to be disposed of she may think proper, all my estate both real & personal of every kind whatever

Item third, I appoint my son Zachariah B Harman Executor to this my last will & testament, this August 5th 1845
