debts be paid as soon as possible by
my executor, out of the first money
that shall come in to their hands
from any portion of my estate real or
Personal. And I also direct that a
fair valuation or appraisement be
made of all my estate. Item 2nd where
I have heretofore given to some of my

 may be seen by an account I have
 kept of the same in a book. My Will
 & desire is that my executor I make up
 is chosen that have had Y^e. equal to
 those that have sons except my son
 Jacob. Whose children shall be in his
 stead. And then all the rest & residue
 of my estate both real & personal as of
 them in otherwise disposed of, may be disposed
 of as is hereafter directed. In order to
 carry into effect my Will & intentions
 I do hereby vest in my executor full &
 ample Power either to sell or to divide
 otherwise as they may deem to be best
 interest & advantage of my estate. And
 my Will & desire is that as soon as
 convenient all my estate not disposed
 herein before be disposed of & distributed in

the following manner Viz To my son
John & the Children of my son Alexander
son Edmund son Timothy each one tenth
part or distributio share, To the child ren
of my son Joel, one tenth part not to
be subject to the payment of any of my
son debts. And my Will is that my son
Joel have a support or maintenance
during his natural life. Item 3^d I give
& bequeath unto my daughter Felicia and
her children one tenth part or equor dis-
tributio share. my daughter Sally nee
Durham & her children one tenth part.
and my wish & Will is that it shall not
be subject to any contract made by
Durham her husband. And to my daughter
Berlinda's children one tenth part and
my Will is that she have as ^{son} coming to
Blanca E. McKinney my grand Daughter

remain hers during her life so that
 no debts contracts can take it. My daugh-
 -ter Nancy Wright & her children one
 tenth part or equal distribution shall
 not to be subject to pay any of Joseph W. W.
 -right's debts it is to be for her support
 & maintenance & her children. and
 my daughter Rebecca Bryant and
 her children one tenth part & for^{to}
 be wholly for their support & use
 there & there & like.

"Oth 5th I here
 wish to name what I owe the two
 daughters of my son Alexander. Mary
 McKinney my grand daughter the part
 which may come to her not to pay any
 contracts made or that may be
 made by him hereafter for it to be hers
 & her children. Also James Grand

daughter of mine to be her part in the same like manner for it cannot be spent for any debts contracted or that may be contracted hereafter but to be for a support for her & for her children after her "

The last Will & Testament of Zachariah
Chambers having been pronounced ^{before me} in open
Court by proving the valid writing of
all the subscribing witnesses & its Testator
there on motion ordered that the same
be administered " August 3^d 1874.

of the Last Will & Testament of Zachariah
Chambers died declined having in writing
to be qualified & Thos E Chambers

Having applied for letters of Administration with the Will annexed. It is ordered that citation be in according to Law.
