Negro man Henry about twenty five years
of age my girl Georgina about fifteen

age my Negro girl Anna about twelve
years of age to her the said Mary Brow-
ning and her children forever I give

of age to her forever I give bequeath

ing his wife the following property to wit
my Negro Girl Milian about twelve years
of age to her forever 12th Item I give bequeath
and devise to my son James W Vaughan
my Negro boy John about five years of age to him
forever 13th Item I give bequeath and devise

to my Grand daughter Caroline Browning
 about eight years of age to her and her
 children forever 14th I intend give bequeath to
 devise to my Grand daughter Montgomery
 my negro girl Mary a black piece of land
 1/2nd also her bed and furniture and one cow
 and calf and ten head of hogs to her forever
 15th I intend desire and direct that the remain-
 der of my property not mentioned in the
 above shall be either be sold by my Ex-
 ecutors hereinafter mentioned and the proceeds
 divided between Richard E. Cherry & Wil-
 liam W. & Charles C. my sons and their
 heirs and a wife of Joseph H. Cherry my daughter
 and living at the 16th I intend hereby to constitute
 appoint my sons Richard E. Cherry &
 Charles C. Cherry my Executors. This will
