ilton my Negro Man Jack I give and bequeath
unto my son William Hamilton and the
woman Tona I give and bequeath unto
my daughter Clorisa Council and the
heirs of her body my Negro Woman Margaret
her child Cully I give and bequeath unto
my daughter Sarah Burck and Rosannah
Willis all the rest and residue of my estate
goods and chattels lands & tenements
After paying all my just debts I nomi-
nate constitute and appoint my son
John Hamilton sole executor of this
my last will and testament hereby
revoking all others & former wills
by me made at any time here-
fore in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal
this the first day of May one thousand
and eighty one and that time
Signed Sealed and Delivered by the said
Testator Clorisa Hamilton as for

her last will & testament in the
presence of us who have subscribed our
names as witnesses & thereto in the
