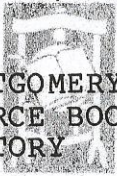

Barber and Moses Barber, and one featherbed and furniture already given by her late husband to his youngest son Samuel Barber. Witnesses: Thomas Davis and Jacob Ricks J.P.

- (p. 77) Peter Edwards to Peter Fair, both of Washington Co. Deed dated September 10, 1796, for 287-1/2 acres granted James Hutchinson. Witnesses: John Rutherford, William Fold.
- (p. 78) Benjamin Blanchard to James Blanchard, both of Burke Conty. Deed dated November 29, 1797, for 287-1/2 acres lying on east side of Oconee River, adjoining Asa Emanuel and R. Fleming. Witnesses: Kinchon Perry, Reubin Blanchard.
- (p. 80) Elijah Clarke, Sr. of Wilkes Co. to William Bush, Sr. of Montg. Co. Deed dated August 4, 1797, for 862-1/2 acres lying on both sides of the Uchee Path, the dividing line between Washington and Montgomery Counties, and on Big Creek and Benton Creek. Witnesses: Samuel Smith, Elijah Blackshear, and David Blackshear J.P.
- (p. 82) Henry Moffet to William Smith, both of Montgomery Co. Deed dated February 5, 1798, for 500 acres lying on Big Creek, granted Robert Jackson December 5, 1793, and by him deeded to grantor October 22, 1796. Witnesses: William Claghorn and Benjamin Evans.
- (p. 84) Arthur Lott, Tax-Collector of Montg. Co., to George Sibbald of Richmond Co. Tax deed dated December 12, 1798, for 140,000 acres surveyed for Patrick Crookshanks and granted him in 1793; levied on and sold for taxes year 1796 due by Thomas Fitzsimmons. Consideration \$30.00. Witnesses: William McCaule and John Hamill, J.P.
- (p. 88) William McCall, Tax-Collector of Montgomery Co. to George Sibbald of Richmond Co. Tax deed dated February 16, 1799, conveying 245,000 acres lying in Montgomery Co., and partly in Liberty Co., granted James Montfort in 1793; levied on and sold as property of Thomas Fitzsimmons for taxes due for year 1797. Witnesses: Arthur Lott and Abner Davis J.P.

- (p. 92) John Taylor of Jefferson Co. to John Jones of Montgomery Co. Deed dated December 28, 1798, for 287-1/2 acres on Oconee River, adjoining grantee's lands. Witnesses: Graland Hardwick and John Shelman J.P.
- (p. 99) William Graves of Lincoln Co. to John Shelman of Jefferson Co. Deed dated August 8, 1798, for 287-1/2 acres on Oconee River, adjoining Samuel Carson and William Lovemore, and granted Nehemiah Wade. Wit: P. L. VanAllen, Henry Ware J.P.
- (p. 106) Nicholas Baker to James Hancock both of Montg. Co. Deed dated November 24, 1795, for 200 acres on Little Ohoopsee River. Witnesses: William Hall and James Sartain J.P. On next page is another deed for same land, from James Hancock to James Sartain. Witnesses: Sherod Swain, Mark Mayo J.P.
- (p. 110) James Sartain to Thomas Davis and Abner Davis, all of Montg. Co. Deed dated January 18, 1798, for above 200 acres. Wit: William Hall, Cader Price.
- (p. 112) James Hancock to James Sartain both of Montg. Co. Bond for Title dated August 20, 1796, for the above 200-acre tract "and being the place where Robert Roberts now lives, and lying on n.e. side of Little Ohoopsee River." Witnesses: Sherod Swain. Transferred by Sartain to Thos. Davis January 18, 1799.
